

# Junior Contests Rules and Guidelines

## **Photo Contest**

### **Categories:**

Seasons, Calves, General Ranch Life, Bulls, Females, Juniors in Action

### **Rules:**

Entries must be submitted via Google Form before 11:59 on October 1, 2025. Entries will open on August 1, 2025.

No more than 1 submissions per category per contestant.

Please submit each entry using separate Google Form responses.

Images must be taken within the last year

Black and White images will be accepted

Photos must be submitted via this [Google Form](#) or they will not be counted towards the contest.

### **Age Divisions:**

Pee Wee (8 & under), Junior (9-13), Intermediate (14-17), Senior (18-21), Adult (22 & over)

### **Prizes:**

1 winner per category will receive \$250 in Bet On Red Sale Credit. Must be present to use prize money. Awards cannot be traded, unless amongst family members.

## **Junior Team Showmanship Contest**

### **Guidelines:**

The primary objective of this contest is to foster collaboration between younger and older junior members. Working as teams, they will collectively guide and support younger members in mastering proper showmanship preparations and exhibition techniques.

### **Rules:**

- Teams of up to 6 (mixed ages)
1. Each team will have a 30-minute time limit to procure an animal and conduct light preparations for the upcoming show.
  2. During this time, older team members will take the opportunity to mentor and guide juniors, instructing them on correct methods and reasoning for fitting the animal.
  3. The Junior Board members will actively supervise the teams, assessing how effectively the older members engage with and assist the younger ones.
  5. Once the preparations are finished, the team member with the least experience will represent the team in the show ring with the animal.
  6. The Junior Board members will be the judges during the exhibition, evaluating each team's performance, and announcing the top two teams based on their showmanship and teamwork skills.

### **Prizes:**

Winning team will have variety of awards to choose from.

## **Judging Contest**

The Junior judging contest is scheduled to take place during the Junior Contests at the Western National Red Angus Show. This unique event will utilize collected images of competitive Red Angus bulls, females, and steers. Live animals will not be part of the judging process. In the event of a tie, reasons will be employed as a tiebreaker to determine the final results.

### **Age Divisions:**

Pee Wee (8 & under), Junior (9-13), Intermediate (14-17), Senior (18-21)

### **Rules:**

- One submission per junior per class
- Exhibitors are required to make their judging decisions independently, without seeking assistance from others. However, in the Pee wee and Junior divisions, participants are allowed to receive help in marking their judging cards.

### **Classes:**

Heifers, Bulls, Cows, Steers, Percentage Females

### **Prizes:**

\$250 sale credit per winner

## **Jeopardy:**

Teams of mixed ages

### **Rules:**

In this competition, teams will demonstrate their knowledge of Red Angus through a series of questions. Each team will have the chance to select a topic and assign a point value, revealing the corresponding question. All teams will have an opportunity to answer, but the first team to signal will have the first chance to respond. If their answer is correct, they will earn the designated points. If they answer incorrectly, the question will move on to the next team. Once all the questions have been answered or attempted, the team with the highest total points will emerge as the winner.

### **Awards:**

Winning team will have variety of awards to choose from.
